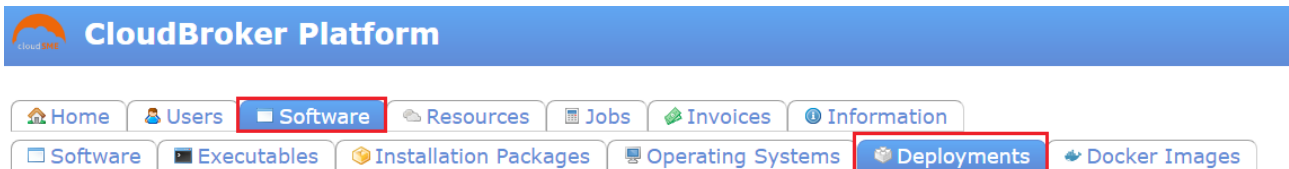


How to delete existing deployments and/or software

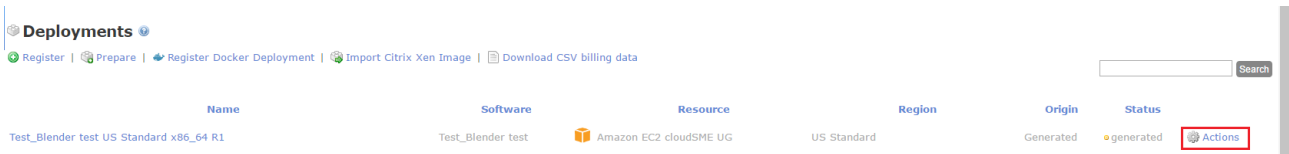
In this tutorial, you will learn how to delete an deployment of your software, or your entire software on the CloudSME-Platform. Like in all of our tutorials, we will use a Blender deployment as an example.

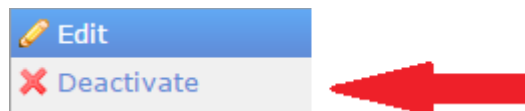


(Fig. 1: Location of the „Deployments“-tab)

1. Log in to the platform and navigate to the „Software“ → „Deployments“-subtab (Fig. 1).

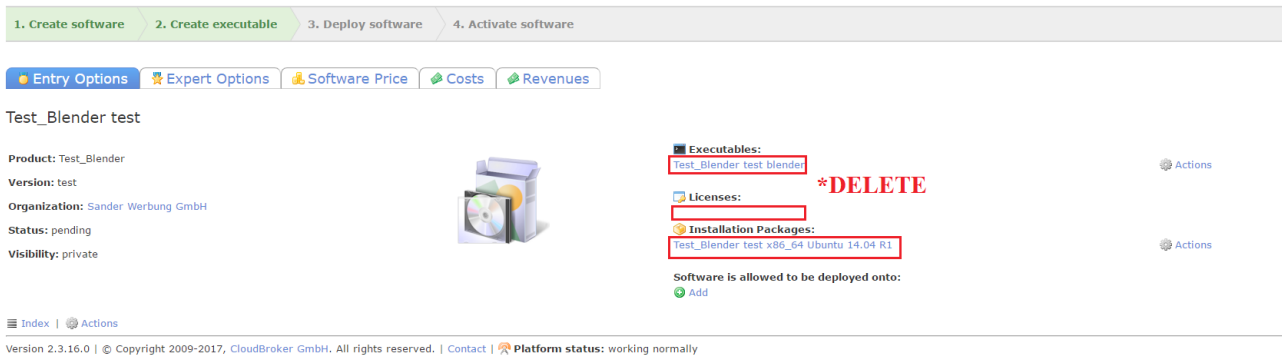
(Fig. 2: Location of the „Action“-button)

2. Hover over the „Actions“-menu of your deployment and select „Deactivate“ (Fig. 2 & Fig. 3) .

3. Once this is done, navigate to your actual software in the „Software“→“Software“-subtab, and open the same „Actions“-menu. Set your software also to „Deactivate“.

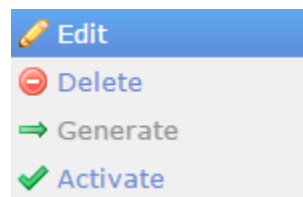
4. After deactivating your software and deployment, It is necessary to delete all related things like the executables, the licenses and so on. To do so, click on the name of the software to open a new detail-page of your software (*Fig. 4*).

5. In the details page, you have to delete your deployment, your executables, your licenses and your installation-packages, In the deployment deletion process the platform asks you, if you want to delete your deployment from the platform or from the platform and from the deployment resource. You have to choose resource (*Fig. 4*).

6. If everything is deleted, navigate again to the „Software“→“Software“-subtab and select the name of your software. Open the „Action“-menu on the left side and delete the entry (*Fig. 5*). If everything was done correctly, your software has been removed completely.
